What is Found Object Sculpture?


- Basically found object sculpture is taking two or more found objects and putting them together in an intentional way.
- The example on the previous page was simply an old frisbee shaped piece of plastic with other circular objects attached to it for eyes.
- Your sculpture does not have to be of an animal they are just easy subject matter.


Using Whole Objects






More Intricate Examples
